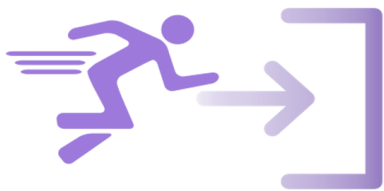


Axial Training's Certificate II in Community Services is an excellent choice for students wanting to develop a pathway into the workforce as community services workers.
